AAC CORNER

"The average 18 month old has been exposed to 4,380 hours of oral language at a rate of 8 hours per day from birth. A child who has a communication system (AAC) and receives speech-language therapy 2 times per week for 20-30 minutes will reach the same amount of language exposure (in their AAC language) in 84 years." – Jane Korsten

It is our responsibility as teachers, parents, support staff, siblings, etc. to fill in this gap. One step you can take is to MODEL. Speak to your child using their communication device/system. Start by modelling just 1 or 2 words at a time. Remember, it is okay if your child doesn't use it! Modelling is all about inputting language at your child's level in your child's language.
